COSMETOLOGY PROGRAM (includes manicuring)

This program consists of 1500 clock hours of academic and “hands-on” instruction, 7.5 hours per day, (8:30 AM - 4:30 PM) (Tue - Fri. and the first two Saturdays of every month.) Tuition includes Salon Fundamentals™ Textbook, online access to Lebanon College’s LAB (Learn About Beauty), and complimentary Cosmetology Kit upon program completion. Enrollment requires you be at least 17 by the time application is made for the state examination and a High School Diploma or GED.

MANICURING PROGRAM

This program consists of 400 clock hours of academic and “hands-on” instruction, 7.5 hours per day, (8:30 AM - 4:30 PM) (Tue - Fri. and the first two Saturdays of every month.) Tuition includes Nail Fundamentals™ Textbook and a complimentary Nail Kit upon program completion. Enrollment requires you be at least 17 by the time application is made for the state examination and a High School Diploma or GED.

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING PROGRAM

This program consists of 600 clock hours of academic and “hands-on” instruction, 7.5 hours per day, (8:30 AM - 4:30 PM) (Tue - Fri. and the first two Saturdays of every month.) Tuition includes textbook and online access to Teaching Fundamentals. Enrollment requires a minimum age of 17, high school diploma, or GED and a valid license from the Cosmetology and Barbering Board.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

✓ **Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**

Lebanon College is approved by the United States Department of Education to participate in Federal Student Aid programs. We participate in the Pell Grant and Direct Loan programs, including Parent Loans for Undergraduate Students (PLUS). Federal Student Aid is awarded to those who qualify. ✓ **Vocational Rehabilitation**

Vocational Rehabilitation approves Lebanon College for student financial assistance. Student applicant must receive enrollment approval from Vocational Rehabilitation prior to receiving financial assistance.

✓ **Veteran Affairs**

The Division of Veteran Affairs approves Lebanon College for student financial assistance. Student applicants must receive enrollment approval from the Veteran Affairs prior to receiving financial assistance.

✓ **Job Training Partnership Act**

The Job Training Partnership for student financial assistance approves Lebanon College for financial assistance. Student applicant must receive enrollment approval from the Division of Job Training prior to receiving financial assistance.

✓ **In House financing**

Lebanon College offers in house financing with 0% interest while in school and attractive interest rates once you graduate. This in house financing is available to help pay the cost of tuition and fees to those who may not qualify for FSA programs.

✓ **Lebanon College High School Scholarship**

Lebanon College offers a yearly scholarship to area high schools for the cosmetology course. The Scholarship amount is \$1,000 and is non-renewable. One Scholarship is awarded per high school. In order to be eligible, the candidate must be at least 17 years of age at the time of enrollment. Candidates should be in the upper 50 % of their graduating class and indicate a definite interest in Cosmetology. Both the high school and Lebanon College choose the recipient. Please check your high school counselor's office for an application.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES INCLUDE

Salon owner; spa owner; manicurist; salon and school supply sales platform demonstrator; school instructor; beauty publication; salon or spa marketing and advertising; cosmetic demonstrator and sales; sculptured nails; hairstyling; styling specialist; skin specialist and company sales consultants (jobs are not limited to the above).

COMPENSATION

Since 1990, NACCAS has commissioned several Job Demand Surveys, to provide quantitative data on cosmetology careers, earnings potential, and job openings. The most recent survey, completed in May 2007, compiles data from 6,203 salons responding to a national survey. **The average annual salary for a salon professional in Missouri is \$30,358. This amount does not include tips and gratuities.** Nationally, the average salon professional's salary is \$35,973. **A dedicated professional stylist or esthetician can set his or her own income goals.**

PHYSICAL DEMANDS OF THE PROFESSION

The only major physical demand is that you be able to stand on your feet for extended periods of time. A cosmetologist, nail tech or esthetician may be scheduled to work at different hours of the day and different days of the week.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

A Cosmetologist, Nail Tech, or Instructor will be working with several different chemicals, cosmetic creams and lotions. If one has a tendency to be allergic, they should be cautious with certain solutions. Rubber gloves and a lab coat should be worn while performing certain hairdressing and skin services. In addition, we utilize many different sharp objects and array of machines used for things such as skin care services.

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

In order to become licensed in the state of Missouri, a person must have graduated from a licensed cosmetology school and passed the Missouri State Board of Cosmetology examination. The examination is in two parts. Part one is a practical examination while part two is a written examination. The applicant must score a minimum of 75% on both parts to receive a passing grade.
